Dear Parents,

You have all chosen to send your kids to overnight summer camp which means you are all very much aware of the positive experiences that your child will encounter; Learning to be independent, socialization skills, living in a close-knit community and appreciating the religious environment while surrounded by appropriate role models; these are just a few of the benefits that we will provide for them. Our goal is to help your children grow and flourish.

Children often question and attempt to push limits especially when a parent is not present. In your absence, we are always working with the campers to learn limits and question in a healthy manner. We have created a document that we have entitled the 'BRIT CHANICH' (Parent/Camper Agreement). Your child needs to read this 'BRIT' together with a parent and it requires the signature of both parties. Signing this document means that you have discussed and agree to the rules stated. I urge you in your discussion to tell your child your expectations regarding these rules. Although we always strive to be proactive, there may be consequences involved when rules are broken. If the behaviour does not improve after we have tried to deal with it, your child will be asked to leave camp. At any time that a zero tolerance rule is broken, the camper will be expelled from camp immediately.

If you need any further explanation on any of the rules stated on the brit, we are available. Together, we will raise a community of compassionate, respectful children. Our partnership is essential.
