

LUGGAGE AND CAMPER DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Luggage tags for Canadians will arrive in the mail with a letter with important information. **For our out of country campers**, If your child is arriving on the morning of departure, your bags will be going at the same time as the campers and you do not need to color code. If you will be in Canada early and you are placing your luggage on a luggage truck the day before, then please either buy colored luggage tags or take a colored construction paper or marker and make your tags visible with the following colors –

All Eidot listed are current grade -

Eidah Aleph (grade 3 and 4) - Orange

Eidah Bet1 (grade 5) - Yellow

Eidah Bet2 (grade 6) - Pink

Eidah Gimmel (grade 7) - Red

Eidah Daled (grade 8) - White

Mach Hach (grade 9) - Green/Blue

Please be sure to attach luggage tags to all the pieces of luggage. Storage space in camp is limited – use duffel bags as they are foldable. The Limit is two bags per child.

Departure for Camp

- In Toronto on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 the buses will be leaving from The Esther Shiner Stadium located at 5720 Bathurst. Please ensure that your child has eaten lunch before he/she boards the bus. Lunch will not be served upon arrival at camp. Buses will begin loading at 1:00 pm and will depart promptly by 1:30 pm. When your child has boarded the bus, he/she will not be allowed off, so please say your goodbyes accordingly.
- In Montreal on Wednesday, July 4, 2018, the bus will be leaving from Hebrew Academy, 5700 Kellert at 8:30 am sharp. Please be sure to send a packed lunch and snacks with your child to have on the bus.
- Ottawa campers will be picked up in Brockville. We will notify you of the details, a few days prior.
- Out of Canada campers- We are still waiting for all the travel documents to arrive to the office so we can inform you about airport pick up. All luggage of out of country campers that will not be able to place luggage on the luggage truck will bring them to camp, the day the campers depart for camp (July 4)

Visiting Day

Visiting Day will take place on Sunday, July 29. Parents are encouraged to visit their children from 12:30 pm until 4:30 pm (city time). You will have the opportunity, to tour the camp and meet our staff. We will be selling food and other items on visiting day. A detailed email will follow.
