## Kiddush Hashem—By Rav Dudi

Shabbat Shalom Camp Moshava Family.

This week at Chinuch we've discussed מחלוקת VS אחדות, disagreement VS unity. This was to elaborate the Tochnit of camp discussing deferent opinions among the Zionist movement.

We've spoken about the importance of a Minyan and shared ideas of how we can make our davening more meaningful.

This week's Parashat Hashavua has a lot of topics within it:  
Parah Aduma, The copper snake, Moshe hitting the rock etc.

When looking into the story of מִי מַרִּיבָה - Moshe hits the rock, many commentators have shared deferent ideas regarding the question – what was Moshe's sin?

The Rambam in שמונה פרקים – his intro to פרקי אבות, brings the following idea:

When Moshe hit the rock he said: "שמעו נא המורים" – listen you rebels.  
This sentence shows that he was angry. His sin therefor was – the fact that he got angry at בני ישראל.

To be honest – after all what יִשְׂרָאֵל did to Moshe – why wouldn't he get upset and angry at them? They keep complaining time after time?

However – מִידָּה explains that anger is the worse attribute.


The role model of the entire Jewish nation can't show anger for even a little bit since every one watch him and might think that if Moshe gets angry – then – anger is not such a bad thing to get angry.

We can learn from this – a very important message:

Madrichim and staff should be very careful with what they do since they are being watched by their chanichim at all times and the chanichim might learn the wrong thing from their behavior.

The same thing apply to chanichim as well. All Jews have the קִדּוּשׁ ה' of מצווה. We have to be careful with everything we do in order to make sure that we don't send the wrong message by the things we do.



## ROSH EIDAH BET 1 Daniel Safran


