Dvar Torah with Rav Gal - Me and My Start-Up Person

In this week's parasha Moshe hands over his leadership to his 'start up person', Yehoshua.

Moshe teaches us that we can never retire from our work or from our responsibilities if we don't make sure that someone else can do the job successfully, instead of us.

You guys are in a young age and you will most likely work in more than one job/role in your life.

As part of Am Yisrael we are obligated to be considerate and care for the people and for our place of work. We need to make sure to pass on our success to other people and to do the best we can to leave our job in the right time, after we find the best people to replace us.

Sometimes we'll need a few or many people and sometimes we only need <u>one</u> person to replace us, like in Moshe's case.

It's not easy to replace someone who was a great success, but on the other hand-IF WE WERE CHOSEN then we have to know that WE CAN DO IT!

Hashem choose all of us to be part of the chain of people who are passing on the Torah! This is similar to a boss who invests in his staff and eventually chooses <u>one</u> of them to replace him completely when he's ready to retire.

B"H I am wishing you all to be the person who excepts the responsibility that you have, whether it's in your bunk, during peulot, during the meals, during davening and so much more!

Make sure to fulfill your obligations but also make sure to pass on your responsibility when you can't fulfill it yourself.
