After growing a fan base through his YouTube covers of Top 40 songs, Edon completed a successful run on the NBC show "America's Got Talent", where he reached the semi-final round out of thousands of auditioning contestants.



Bnei Akiva - More Than Al Youth Movement Who Are We? אברדבר Bnei Akiva - בני עקיבא

Bnei Akiva inspires and empowers young Jews with a sense of commitment to the Jewish people, the Land of Israel and the Torah. Bnei Akiva around the world runs weekly activities, summer and winter camps, tours and gap years in Israel, and so much more!

We are an inclusive youth movement, so while we have high religious standards, everyone is welcome. And wherever you go in the world, you'll find Bnei Akiva — we have branches in 37 countries all over the globe!

'Bnei Akiva' means 'the children of Akiva', and our ideology relates directly to the story of Rabbi Akiva. At the age of 40, after growing up tending flock, he decided that he needed to find out the essence of the Jewish faith. He reasoned that just as something as soft as water can penetrate a solid rock and cause it to erode, so too can the Torah penetrate into himself. We endeavour to follow Rabbi Akiva's qualities, namely his love of Hashem, his devotion to the Torah, his love of Israel and the fight for its independence, and respect for work.

How Do We Live? אָרִיינַרָּרְ? Torah WAyodah -תורה ועבודה

Torah Ve'Avodah is an outlook on the world which synthesizes a religious life of Torah with labor and production in order to bring about a national renaissance of the Jewish people in the Land of Israel.

It's a life based on the torah's vision of an ideal lifestyle fulfilled through the modern world. We feel that although all our ideology comes from the Torah, we must emphasize the work needed in order to make the torah turn from words into action. We believe in the state of Israel as a modern Jewish state with the responsibility to be a moral role model to the rest of the world.

Bnei Akiva gives young Jewish people a framework to live a religious lifestyle in the modern world and a mission to make an active contribution to our community and the State of Israel.





The objective of Religious Zionism is to combine the concepts of the Nation of Israel (AM Yisrael), the Land of Israel (Eretz Yisrael), and the Law of Israel (Torat Yisrael) into one ideal. The nation represents the unity of all Jews around the world as one nation with a common vision. Central to this vision is the Land of Israel. We look to Jewish Law to define this shared vision as well as to accomplish our purpose as the Jewish Nation. We are proud to be Jews and feel the Jewish nation should be marching with its head up to accomplish this vision.

The Zionist dream is concretized in the statement, of In the Land of Israel by the Law of the Torah of Israel. While one certainly can be a proud and halachic Jew in the Diaspora, the fulfillment of the Torah can not be complete without life in Israel.

While Bnei Akiva in the Diaspora tends to focus on Aliyah, Bnei Akiva in Israel focuses on community building, Chessed and developing religious national pride.

Camp Moshava Ennismore

We're more than a camp, we're a family

In 1959, Camp Moshava moved to the shores of Lake Buckhorn in Ennismore, Ontario on to land purchased under the direction of Nachum Sokol z'l. From the outset, the camp's leadership envisioned Moshava as a Bnei Akiva youth Movement camp, founded on the ideals of Torah V'avodah, a phrase coined by Rav Shmuel Chaim Landau (known as the



Shachal), while also emphasising social and recreational experience.


We are a co-ed, modern orthodox camp catering to campers in grade 2-10 for a 2, 4 or 6 week program.

Camp is now in its 56th summer but some things never change. Waking up to the ram kol (loud speaker), joining your Eidah for mifkad (roll call) to start the day, tefillah 3 times daily, colour war, a sea of dark and white spanking clean wave of people as we gather for a camp wide mifkad before Shabbat, slow shira as the sun is setting and we say goodbye to Shabbat... all of these beautiful traditions make Camp Moshava so special. But through the years we have moved forward with so many amazing capital improvements...



In the past 7 years alone we have built or added the following - an office extension, kitchen facility for tzevet (staff), new head staff cabins, 8 new camper cabins, a state of the art Beit kneset (Synagogue), a new shekem (canteen), teva area (nature and animals), arts and crafts extension, an agam (lake) extension, 12 new kayaks, water trampoline, water swing and slide, 2 new power boats, new kitchen appliances,

new ventilation systems in dining hall and rec centre, zip line, double ropes swing, baseball diamond, 3 basketball areas and tennis court.





In the past 2 years we have also run an extremely successful program called Megamot. For two hours, once a week, campers either leave camp or stay in camp to enjoy specialty programming run by professional companies in neighbouring Peterborough. Megamot have included horseback riding, golf, paint ball, ceramics, science with Trent University, water sports, drama, painting and more.

With all these outstanding programs, we still concentrate on educating our campers. We do not believe that chinuch (education) takes a



rest in the summer, quite the opposite. Informal education run by fantastic young adults who serve as important role models is the more idyllic way to inspire and engage kids. We



learn in formal classes every day but we also have morning cocoa club for kids to start their day learning even before the ram kol (load speaker goes off), we have menucha beit midrash were kids can come learn with staff during rest time, we have tefillah work shops were kids are learning the meaning of prayers, we give every camper at every age the opportunity to stand up and make a dvar torah at any meal and we also have an educational theme every single summer that helps educate our campers on important subjects.

We are busting at the seams with over 300 campers over a 6 week period in summer 2014 and a wait list. 30% of our camp population is from Montreal, 45% from Toronto and the balance from other provinces as well as Israel, US and even Italy... won't you join is for a summer of a lifetime?








A Real Moshava Love Story



On a warm Sunday in late June, at a time when teenagers' transistor radios were blaring Elvis Presley and Roy Orbison, a handful of teenagers from Montreal met a similar group from Toronto in the parking lot of the Shaarei Tefillah synagogue in Toronto. The group, counselors for Camp Moshava Ennismore, waited for the bus that was to take them to camp, days before the campers were to arrive. And that's where my parents met.
