Parshat Korach with Rav Boaz

Before we speak about Korach I would like to share with all of the readers that today, as I was cleaning up the Beit Knesset, I met three incredible young women, true **צדיקות** who in my eyes are the ANTIDOTE to Korach and I'll tell you why at the end of this Dvar Torah. They are (drum roll please..) **Tamara Goldman, Sasha Aaron and Serena Ames** - all from **עידה ד'**

This week's parsha is named for the infamous Korach who instigated, planned and orchestrated a major rebellion against the leadership of Moshe and the position of Aharon, the Kohen Gadol!

Not only did Korach make a lot of trouble for Moshe but he was a pretty bad influence on his neighbors in Shevet Reuven including Datan, Aviram, On-Ben-Pelet and 250 major league leaders who all rallied around Korach defiantly challenging Moshe's intentions and his authority!

Korach and his 'comrades of conflict' didn't appreciate that Moshe, the leader of the Jewish People, gave his brother, Aharon, the second most important position in the Nation! Perhaps, each one of them thought HE could be the Kohen Gadol. They were all great people, each in their own right, but they weren't satisfied with their own tafkidim and sought a position that simply wasn't meant for them. They refused to acknowledge that it wasn't MOSHE who appointed Aharon High Priest, but HASHEM! Korach and his clan were all divinely punished, some through a heavenly fire and others miraculously swallowed up by the earth!

What does this have to do with our girls??? The letters of Korach's name is hinted to in the last letters of a pasuk about Tamar(a):

צדיק כתר יפרח

You see, Korach had the potential to be a tzaddik (like **Tamara**) because like **Serena** (which means a royal dignitary) he was an impressive and distinguished man! But he wanted to do a position that was not his! For this he was punished through a נס (did you know that **Sasha's** Hebrew name is נסיה?). When the girls, who had a period free (!!!), saw me cleaning the Beit Knesset, they immediately asked if they could help volunteering **to do a job which was not their own!** Unlike Korach, this was not for their own personal gain, rather to HELP THE KLAL! KOL HAKAVOD GIRLS!!! YOU are the ANTIDOTE to Korach and his Eidah's selfish motivation! Korach claimed that the whole EIDAH are KEDOSHIM, Holy People; if Tamara, Sasha and Serena are typical of the chanichim in EIDAH DALED then they are truly a HOLY EIDAH!

DVAR TORAH: SHAMSHON FRIEDMAN

Imagine you are driving a car and during your trip, your car door is frustrated that the engine has a more involved role in the driving process. This is crazy! The car requires both the door and the engine to be fully functional in order for it to drive comfortably. This happens similarly in parshat Korach. Korach feels that his role is too minor in the journey of the Jewish nation. Korach then decides to gather a group of like-minded individuals and demand that Moshe give them more power. This aggravated Moshe because they didn't realize that their role was also important. Moshe could not be standing where he was if not for them being who they were. As Jews, we all have a responsibility to be Ovdei HaShem. Since everyone as an individual has different strengths and weaknesses and has so much to offer, we should all realize that as a whole, we are all here to accomplish the same mission. This is related to the importance of attending minyan. Individually, our tefillot are unique. Each one of us has different approaches of talking to HaShem through their emotions and experiences. But as a minyan, we have a shared goal. Our tefillah as a minyan is the same. However, the minyan can only exist with the combination of individuals regardless of their level of involvement. Korach should have understood that without his individuality and contribution to Bnei Yisrael, Moshe could not be a leader.

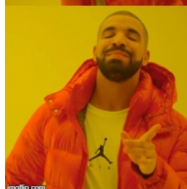
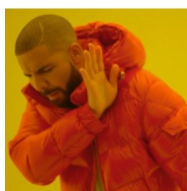

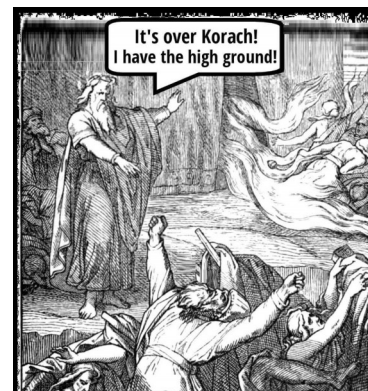
